

The Ro-Man 2019 Organizing Committee invites proposals for Automated solutions with a social impact. IEEE RoMan's **Socialis Impremiere** will be organised in Le Meridien, Windsor Place, within the Ro-Man conference from 14th -19th October 2019, consistent with the overall theme "Responsible Robotics and AI for the Real World".



Theme:

Through this competition, a unique opportunity is provided to Undergraduate, Postgraduate and PhD students show off the state-of-the-art implementation of robot technologies. The solutions should focus on "Robotics in Social Context"

"Social context" includes but not limited to:

- Healthcare: Preventive or Interventional
- Waste management
- Agricultural Innovation
- Energy Production/Regulation
- Water Purification/ Distribution
- Disaster Prevention/ Evacuation
- Traffic Regulation and Management

Anything other Innovative Exhibition in the social context.



Judging Criteria:

Teams will be provided upto **15 minutes** before an experienced jury panel to present their Product/Innovation The Exhibition should include a demonstration of a working prototype. The presentation in **PPT format** should include (but is not limited to):

- The use case and social impact of their product.
- Development procedure or future plans of implementation
- Utility and Practical Feasibility
- Cost estimation of the prototype and the final product.

Registration Procedure:

The Registration fee for **Teams of upto 4 Members is INR 5000** and for **Teams of upto 2 Members is INR 2500**. Registration does not include accommodation and transport for the participants.
